



Meal Charge/Unpaid Meal Service

Student Charge/Unpaid Debt Policy:

The Appalachian Challenge Academy participates in the National School Lunch and Breakfast Program. The Academy is classified as a Residential Child Care Institution (RCCI) and utilizes a Statement of Facts method to determine eligibility for free and reduced price meals. Our students receive all meals at no cost, additionally there are no extra or a la carte items sold, therefore there is no charge policy needed for these items. Since there is a Statement of Facts on file in CNIPS as part of our approval application, not other eligibility information is needed for our students.

Student Unpaid Debt Policy:

All meal service is at no charge and there is no ala carte or extra items are sold to cadets, therefor there is no policy needed for unpaid student debt.

Adult Charge/Unpaid Debt Policy

Staff members of the Academy who are enrolled in MySchoolBucks, a prepaid service, are eligible to purchase breakfast and lunch at the Academy. The charge for Breakfast is \$3.39 and the charge for lunch is \$5.12. These meals are sold through the Point of Sale software. Any participant who does not have the funds in their account to cover the cost of the meal will not be served. We do not allow meals to be charged, this eliminates the possibility of unpaid debt.
